At a duly called Regular Meeting of the Council held this 27th day of January 2024, the following Order was adopted.

WHEREAS; On July 22, 2023, the citizens of the Upper Mattaponi Tribe ("Tribe") voted to adopt a new constitution ("Constitution") to assert the Tribe's sovereign authority as an Indian Tribe, and to confirm and to reorganize the Tribe to exercise its full governmental authority in a fair and equitable manner; and,

WHEREAS; the Council recognizes and appreciates the importance of adopting rules and procedures relating to its duties under the law and consequently in this Order is adopting same for its use; and

WHEREAS; The Council is vested with the authority to pass Legislative Rules and govern its internal administrative and operational matters, to employ staff, to contract for goods and services, and to establish legislative procedures pursuant to Article VII, Section 4(h) of the Constitution. Such Orders, as these, are not subject to consideration by the Chief, and become effective on the date set forth above.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council hereby enacts the attached order entitled, "Rules and Procedures of the Council of the Mattaponi Tribe"; and,
